

- 300 books
- Protestant 'systematic theology'
- Catholic St Paul 'primary source EC'
- Mar Thoma: St Paul the 'architect'
- Books: Missionary Methods: St Paul's or Ours?
- Language: 'Conversion', and 'being saved'
- etc

St Paul's gospel explanation

■ 'Gospel .. Regarding his son' Rom 1:3

power of God for salvation'
Rom 1:16

 Delivered to death for our sins and raised to life for our justification'
 Rom 4: 25

 Wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ'

Rom 6:23

■ 'Grace given you in Christ Jesus' 1Cor 1:4

'sent .. To preach the gospel'
1Cor 1:17

 'we preach Christ crucified .. Christ the power of God'







- Possible answers to question: 'what must I do to inherit eternal life'.



The '360 Gospel of Jesus'


Jesus model is not 'one size fits all'. Just like the facets of a diamond it depends on the angle as to what you see.

Mission together - principle

Christ's intercessory (high priestly) prayer

'I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.'

John 17: 20b,21.

The compass: '360' gospel of Jesus

Principles:

- 1. Three stories
- 2. Their story and God's story > my story
- 3. What they hear is more important than what I say
- 4. At appropriate time, name the name of Jesus
- 5. Don't point finger Jesus didn't
- 6. The motivation, and the gift, is love
- 7. John 3:16 'gospel in a nutshell'
